Once again our Elks Monday Night football group decide to do a little extra and adopt Marines during the holidays. Our original goal was to help two families, but because of the support we received we were able to help three families. All of the kids received toys and clothes (we had some help with suggestions from their parents). The adults were given gift cards to their favorite stores and also gift cards to share with their families. Like last year, all the Warriors were honored and thankful that we could help their families and asked nothing for themselves. I feel it necessary to include a picture and a short bio of our heroes. Any mention of their injuries is short and brief.

Sgt. Dawn: During her first Tour in Afghanistan Dawn's main job was to "sweep" the desert for IEDs. She took several hits from IED's but the final one "really did a number on her". During her second tour she handled administrative work since she was still recovering from her injuries. She was very open about the PTSD she still suffers from but attributes her ongoing recovery to her daughter Rosie (2 years old). Her daughter spent the entire time opening her presents and had to wear her new pink princess slippers.

Sgt. Robert: One tour in Iraq and two tours in Afghanistan. He did not mention which tour he was injured, but was receiving a medical release from the Marines. Sgt. Robert and his wife have three kids, two sons 16 and 11 and a daughter 10. I asked the kids to grab their favorite gift for a picture. They all grabbed their tablets, but the excited 16 year old also put on his Angel hoodie and Laker hat (also notice Sgt. Robert put on his Kings jacket and hat). Their daughter touched our hearts by being so excited for the gifts her brothers had received and was very happy when she opened all the arts and crafts projects she was given.

Staff Sgt. Joe (one of last year's Warriors) had a stroke just after Christmas last year. He had to relearn to talk and walk again. He mentioned it was a tough year of rehabbing and is still limited physically. Since his family was not able to take advantage of the Disneyland trip we had set up for them last year, we were fortunate that an Elk family member who works at Disneyland has offered to make their dream come true. He also mentioned that he is retiring and would like to stay in beach area.

This year we were happy that two couples from the Elks joined us on our trip to the base. They were able to share the rewarding and touching moments while delivering the gifts.

As mentioned last year, the raising of the money was easy compared standing in front of a true patriot and wife thanking us for making their kid's holiday special. None of this is possible without the support our patriot friends, we are humbled and blessed.




